
**ORDER ON MOTION TO DECLARE DANIEL T. O'DELL A VEXATIOUS
LITIGANT AND TO REVOKE HIS STATUS AS A PAUPER**

On this the 22nd day of February, 2001, came on to be heard Defendant Peak's Motion to Declare Daniel T. O'Dell a vexatious litigant and to revoke his status as a pauper, and the Court is of the opinion that the following order should issue:

- 1) Daniel T. O'Dell is hereby declared a vexatious litigant;
- 2) Daniel T. O'Dell is hereby ORDERED to furnish security for the benefit of Defendant Peak, as required by TEX. CIV. PRAC. & REM. CODE § 11.051 and 11.056, in the amount of \$ 100 00;
- 3) Daniel T. O'Dell is hereby PROHIBITED from filing, *in propria persona*, a new litigation in the State of Texas without first obtaining permission, pursuant to TEX. CIV. PRAC. & REM. CODE § 11.102(a), from the local administrative judge in the jurisdiction and venue in which Daniel T. O'Dell seeks to file the litigation;
- 4) The clerk of this court is ordered to provide to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System a copy of this order, and Daniel T. O'Dell's name shall be added to and maintained on the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System's list of vexatious litigants subject to pre-filing orders.

It is further ordered, adjudged, and decreed that Daniel T. O'Dell's affidavit of indigence/inability to pay is hereby stricken and nullified, and Daniel T. O'Dell shall pay costs of court as required of any non-pauper litigant.
