IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no later than 10 business days after receipt of the relevant criminal history record information contained in this order or a copy of this order from the clerk, DPS shall seal the criminal history record information that is the subject of this order and forward the information or copy of the order to all state and federal agencies listed in § 411.075(b), Gov't Code, by certified mail (return receipt requested) or secure electronic mail, electronic transmission, or facsimile transmission, in accordance with § 411.075(b), Gov't Code.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an agency or entity shall seal any criminal history record information maintained by that agency or entity that is the subject of this order no later than 30 business days after the date that the agency or entity received relevant criminal history record information contained in this order or a copy of this order from DPS or a clerk, in accordance with § 411.075(d), Gov't Code.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk shall seal all court records containing information that is the subject of this order as soon as practicable after the date that the clerk sends a copy of this order or all relevant criminal history record information contained in this order to DPS, in accordance with § 411.076(b), Gov't Code.
