



Mena Ramón to Serve as Interim Administrative Director of the Office of Court Administration

AUSTIN – Maria Elena (Mena) Ramón, General Counsel for the Texas Office of Court Administration, has been named Interim Administrative Director of the Office of Court Administration (OCA).

The Texas Supreme Court [approved](#) Ramón to replace David Slayton, who joined the National Center for State Courts as Vice President of Court Consulting Services. Ramón will serve until a new OCA administrative director is hired.

Ramón has been general counsel since January 2009 and has worked at OCA for more than 20 years. Before that, she worked in private practice in Alpine, Texas and with the Texas General Land Office for more than six years. As general counsel, she works with judicial boards and commissions and advises the special committees that review judicial records requests denied under Texas Rule of Judicial Administration Rule 12. She also oversees procurement and negotiates all contracts for the agency.

She earned a bachelor's degree in journalism and law degree from the University of Texas at Austin.
