**ORDER DECLARING PLAINTIFF A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT**  
**AND PRE-FILING ORDER**

This matter is before the Court on this the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of March, 2010, pursuant to Defendants' Motion for Order Declaring Plaintiff a Vexatious Litigant and for Security, and Motion for Pre-Filing Order. Plaintiff, Kristofer Kastner, was present *pro se*. Defendants were present through their counsel of record, Assistant Attorney General Ted A. Ross. Having reviewed Defendants' motions and supplement thereto, and Plaintiff's response, and having heard the evidence and arguments of (54) the parties, the Court finds that Defendants have satisfied the requirements of Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code § 11.054(2)(A) and (B) regarding the criteria for finding Plaintiff to be a vexatious litigant. The Court further finds that Defendants have satisfied the requirements of Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code § 11.101(a) regarding the issuance of a pre-filing order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Defendants' Motion for Order Declaring Plaintiff a Vexatious Litigant and for Security is GRANTED, and Plaintiff is hereby declared to be a vexatious litigant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code § 11.055,


Plaintiff shall furnish security for Defendants' costs and attorneys' fees in this proceeding, either by cash deposit with the Travis County District Clerk or by surety bond to be approved by the Court, in the amount of \$ 37,000<sup>00</sup> ~~000~~.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this case, including all discovery, is stayed in its entirety unless and until Plaintiff furnishes the security required by this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the security ordered herein shall be furnished by Plaintiff not later than ~~March~~ April 2, 2010, or this case shall be dismissed ~~with prejudice~~. S.Y.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants' Motion for Pre-Filing order is GRANTED, and that Plaintiff is hereby prohibited from filing, in propria persona, any further litigation in the State of Texas against any of the Defendants in this proceeding, unless Plaintiff first secures the permission of the local administrative judge of the court in which Plaintiff intends to file such litigation.
